The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.

Hebrew Meaning

* Yahweh - God's personal name

lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word הַּוֹהְ (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (פַּחְדָּוֹ עַל כָּל הַגּוֹיֶם

NIV So David's fame spread throughout every land, and the LORD made all the nations fear him.

NLT So David's fame spread everywhere, and the LORD caused all the nations to fear David.
