Hebrew	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (אֲחִיהֶם הַמְשִׁרְרִים בְּכָלִי שִׁיר נְבָלִים וְכִנֹּרוֹת וּמִצְלִתִּים מְשַׁמְעִים לְהָרִים בְּקוֹל לְשִׁמְחָה
ESV	David also commanded the chiefs of the Levites to appoint their brothers as the singers who should play loudly on musical instruments, on harps and lyres and cymbals, to raise sounds of joy.
NIV	David told the leaders of the Levites to appoint their brothers as singers to sing joyful songs, accompanied by musical instruments: lyres, harps and cymbals.
NLT	David also ordered the Levite leaders to appoint a choir of Levites who were singers and musicians to sing joyful songs to the accompaniment of harps, lyres, and cymbals.
