ESV	Chenaniah, leader of the Levites in music, should direct the music, for he understood it.
NIV	Kenaniah the head Levite was in charge of the singing; that was his responsibility because he was skillful at it.
NLT	Kenaniah, the head Levite, was chosen as the choir leader because of his skill.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” Χωνενια ἄρχων τῶν ἡ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ Λευιτῶν ἄρχων τῶν ἡ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ὧδῶν ὅτι συνετὸς ἦν εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
