	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהֵים (הָאֶרֶץ plugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigy, אֶרֶץ

	Meaning:
	* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country
	The word אֶכֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.
	When coupled with heavens (שָׁמֵיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1
ESV	Then shall the trees of the forest sing for joy before the LORD, for he comes to judge the earth.
NIV	Then the trees of the forest will sing, they will sing for joy before the LORD, for he comes to judge the earth.
NLT	Let the trees of the forest rustle with praise, for the LORD is coming to judge the earth.

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1
