	יהוה יהוה hebrew Meaning Hebrew * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	So David left Asaph and his brothers there before the ark of the covenant of the LORD to minister regularly before the ark as each day required,
NIV	David left Asaph and his associates before the ark of the covenant of the LORD to minister there regularly, according to each day's requirements.
NLT	David arranged for Asaph and his fellow Levites to serve regularly before the Ark of the LORD's Covenant, doing whatever needed to be done each day.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
