Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” **ὁὖν** οὕτως ἐρεῖς **τῷ**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article **δούλῳ μου** Δαυὶδ **τάδε λέγει κύριος παντοκράτωρ** ἔλαβόν σε ἐκ τῆςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article **μάνδρας** ἐξόπισθεν **τῶν**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article **ποιμνίων τοῦ**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

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The definite article **εἶναι**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμί

εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. **εἰς ἡγούμενον ἐπὶ τὸν**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ
