The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.

This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.

* Yahweh - God's personal name

lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוֹה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

The Hebrew אַת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֶים (דָּוִּיד בְּּכָל אֱשֶׁר הָלֶד

ESV Then he put garrisons in Edom, and all the Edomites became David's servants. And the LORD gave victory to David wherever he went.

NIV He put garrisons in Edom, and all the Edomites became subject to David. The LORD gave David victory everywhere he went.

NLT He placed army garrisons in Edom, and all the Edomites became David's subjects. In fact, the LORD made David victorious wherever he went.
