	אתָּplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (יִשְׂרָאֵל וַיְהִי יְהוֹנָתָן בֶּן שִׁמְעָא אֶחָיו דָּוִד
ESV	And when he taunted Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea, David's brother, struck him down.
NIV	When he taunted Israel, Jonathan son of Shimea, David's brother, killed him.
NLT	But when he defied and taunted Israel, he was killed by Jonathan, the son of David's brother Shimea.
LXX	καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. KJV	But when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea David's brother slew him.
