ESV	Also to his son Shemaiah were sons born who were rulers in their fathers' houses, for they were men of great ability.
NIV	His son Shemaiah also had sons, who were leaders in their father's family because they were very capable men.
NLT	Obed-edom's son Shemaiah had sons with great ability who earned positions of great authority in the clan.

Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὅτι δυνατοὶ ἦσανplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
