| Hebrew | hebrew<br>The Hebrew אֶחָד word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.<br>For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by אֶלֶיךָ וְאֶתְּכֶם וְאֶתְּכֶם אֶלֶיךָ            |
| ESV    | This is the number of the people of Israel, the heads of fathers' houses, the commanders of thousands and hundreds, and their officers who served the king in all matters concerning the divisions that came and went, month after month throughout the year, each division numbering 24,000: |
| NIV    | This is the list of the Israelites-heads of families, commanders of thousands and commanders of hundreds, and their officers, who served the king in all that concerned the army divisions that were on duty month by month throughout the year. Each division consisted of 24,000 men.       |
| NLT    | This is the list of Israelite generals and captains, and their officers, who served the king by supervising the army divisions that were on duty each month of the year. Each division served for one month and had 24,000 troops.                                                            |

Related to the verb λέγω.</div><div>λόγος in Greek Thought</div><div>Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things.
