ESV	Eighth, for the eighth month, was Sibbecai the Hushathite, of the Zerahites; in his division were 24,000.
NIV	The eighth, for the eighth month, was Sibbecai the Hushathite, a Zerahite. There were 24,000 men in his division.
NLT	Sibbecai, a descendant of Zerah from Hushah, was commander of the eighth division of 24,000 troops, which was on duty during the eighth month.
