ESV	Ninth, for the ninth month, was Abiezer of Anathoth, a Benjaminite; in his division were 24,000.
NIV	The ninth, for the ninth month, was Abiezer the Anathothite, a Benjamite. There were 24,000 men in his division.
NLT	Abiezer from Anathoth in the territory of Benjamin was commander of the ninth division of 24,000 troops, which was on duty during the ninth month.
