Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
