	כִּי־יָחִיזְק׃ Meaning * To be firm * Establish * Prepare * Set Verb. Occurs about 200 times in the Old Testament. Meanings by Stem Qal Stem (basic form) To be firm, stable, fixed, established. Describes something that stands securely or endures. Psalm 93:2 Psalm 103:19 Proverbs 16:9 Psalm 96:102 Samuel 7:16 Proverbs 16:3 Luke 22:321 Peter 5:101 Corinthians 1:8 Hebrews 2:3 Colossians 1:23 Matthew 25:34 hebrew The Hebrew יָחִיזְק word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (מְלָכִיתוֹ עַד לְעוֹלָם אִם יִחַזֵּק לַעֲשׂוֹת מִצְוֹתַי וּמִשְׁפָּטַי בַּיּוֹם הַזֶּה
