In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (מְכִיר אָבִי גִלְעָד
ESV	The sons of Manasseh: Asriel, whom his Aramean concubine bore; she bore Machir the father of Gilead.
NIV	The descendants of Manasseh: Asriel was his descendant through his Aramean concubine. She gave birth to Makir the father of Gilead.
NLT	The descendants of Manasseh through his Aramean concubine included Asriel. She also bore Makir, the father of Gilead.
