

1 Corinthians 10:8

	μηδὲ πορνεύωμεν, καθὼς τινες αὐτῶν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
Greek	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐπόρνευσαν, καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἔπεσαν μὲν ἡμέρᾳ εἴκοσι τρεῖς χιλιάδες.
ESV	We must not indulge in sexual immorality as some of them did, and twenty-three thousand fell in a single day.
NIV	We should not commit sexual immorality, as some of them did—and in one day twenty-three thousand of them died.
NLT	And we must not engage in sexual immorality as some of them did, causing 23,000 of them to die in one day.
KJV	Neither let us commit fornication, as some of them committed, and fell in one day three and twenty thousand.

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
