It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. μὴ ἔχω, γένοναplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγίνομαι greek Meaning * To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass Verb. ESV	If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.
NIV	If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal.
NLT	If I could speak all the languages of earth and of angels, but didn't love others, I would only be a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.
KJV	Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

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
