εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. νήπιος, ἐλάλουν ὡς νήπιος, ἐφρόνου ὡς νήπιος, ἐλογιζόμεν ὡς νήπιος· ὅτε γέγονα ἀνὴρ, κατήργηκα τὰ plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigὁ
