Greek	ὥστε αἱ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. προφητεία οὐ τοῖς greek Meaning: * The The definite article. 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ESV	Thus tongues are a sign not for believers but for unbelievers, while prophecy is a sign not for unbelievers but for believers.
NIV	Tongues, then, are a sign, not for believers but for unbelievers; prophecy, however, is for believers, not for unbelievers.
NLT	So you see that speaking in tongues is a sign, not for believers, but for unbelievers. Prophecy, however, is for the benefit of believers, not unbelievers.
KJV	Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe.

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
