	The definite article ὑμετέραν καύχησιν, ἀδελφοί, ἣν ἔχω ἐν
	greek
	Preposition meaning “in”. Χριστῷ
	Christ means “anointed one”
	The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)
ESV	Noun, masculine. Ἰησοῦ τῷ
	greek
	The definite article κυρίῳ ἡμῶν.
NIV	I protest, brothers, by my pride in you, which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die every day!
NLT	I die every day—I mean that, brothers—just as surely as I glory over you in Christ Jesus our Lord.
KJV	For I swear, dear brothers and sisters, that I face death daily. This is as certain as my pride in what Christ Jesus our Lord has done in you.
KJV	I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.
