Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man is from heaven. **ESV** The first man was of the dust of the earth, the second man from heaven. NIV Adam, the first man, was made from the dust of the earth, while Christ, the second man, came NLT from heaven. KJV The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.
