Different from εἰμί (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event. It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκενὸς ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκυρίῳ.
