	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ὑμῶν ἐν

greek	Preposition meaning "in". ἀγάπη γινέσθω.

	* To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass
	Verb.
	Different from εἶμι (which means "to be" - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10

	Let all your things be done with charity.
