	Christ means “anointed one”
	The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)
	Noun, masculine. καὶ

	Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” οἰκονόμους μυστηρίων θεοῦ. greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God
ESV	This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.
NIV	So then, men ought to regard us as servants of Christ and as those entrusted with the secret things of God.
NLT	So look at Apollos and me as mere servants of Christ who have been put in charge of explaining God's mysteries.
KJV	Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.

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
