Greek	Οὐκ ἐντρέπων ὑμᾶς γράφω ταῦτα, plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἀλλ’ ὡς τέκνα μου ἀγαπητὰ νουθετῶν.
ESV	I do not write these things to make you ashamed, but to admonish you as my beloved children.
NIV	I am not writing this to shame you, but to warn you, as my dear children.
NLT	I am not writing these things to shame you, but to warn you as my beloved children.
KJV	I write not these things to shame you, but as my beloved sons I warn you.

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
