	Verb. Different from εἰμί (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10
ESV	I urge you, then, be imitators of me.
NIV	Therefore I urge you to imitate me.
NLT	So I urge you to imitate me.
KJV	Wherefore I beseech you, be ye followers of me.
