IT is most frequently translated as “and” τοῦτο οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἀδελφούς.
ESV	But you yourselves wrong and defraud- even your own brothers!
NIV	Instead, you yourselves cheat and do wrong, and you do this to your brothers.
NLT	Instead, you yourselves are the ones who do wrong and cheat even your fellow believers.
KJV	Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that your brethren.
