It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. μήπως ήplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigό greek The definite article ἐξουσία ὑμῶν αὕτηplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὔτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὔτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 πρόσκομμα γένηταιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγίνομαι greek Meaning * To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass Verb. Different from εἰμί (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10 τοῖςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigό greek The definite article ἀσθενέσιν.
ESV	But take care that this right of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak.
