	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. γινώσκετε ὅτι καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πᾶς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπᾶς

	Meaning
	* All * Every * The whole
	Adjective.
	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

	The definite article ποιῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιεῶ
	Meaning:
	* To do * To make
	This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.
	Verb forms
	Present tense Person Greek Form τῇν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

	The definite article δικαιοσύνην ἐξ αὐτοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός
	greek
	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) γεγέννηται .

ESV	If you know that he is righteous, you may be sure that everyone who practices righteousness has been born of him.
NIV	If you know that he is righteous, you know that everyone who does what is right has been born of him.
NLT	Since we know that Christ is righteous, we also know that all who do what is right are God's children.
KJV	If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him.
