Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) τετελειωμένη ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἡμῖν ἐστίν.plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
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ESV	No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.
NIV	No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.
NLT	No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us.
KJV	No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

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
