Greek	ἐάν τις εἴπῃ ὅτι ἀγαπῶ τὸν greek The definite article θεόν, greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τὸν greek The definite article ἀδελφὸν αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) μισῇ, Πεύστης ἐστίν. greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁ greek The definite article γὰρ μὴ ἀγαπῶν τὸν greek The definite article ἀδελφὸν αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὃν ἐώρακεν, τὸν greek The definite article θεὸν greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God ὃν οὐχ ἐώρακεν οὐ δύναται ἀγαπᾶν.
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ESV	If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.
NIV	If anyone says, "I love God," yet hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen.
NLT	If someone says, "I love God," but hates a Christian brother or sister, that person is a liar; for if we don't love people we can see, how can we love God, whom we cannot see?
KJV	If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

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
