Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 γινώσκωμεν ὅτι ἀγαπῶμεν τὰplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

The definite article θεοῦ,plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God ὅταν τὸνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

The definite article θεὸνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

Greek Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God ἀγαπῶμεν καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" τὰςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

The definite article ἐντολὰς αὐτοῦplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

Meaning

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Meaning:

* To do * To make

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

Verb forms

Present tense Person Greek Form

ESV	By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments.
NIV	This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands.
NLT	We know we love God's children if we love God and obey his commandments.
KJV	By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
