	Christ means “anointed one”
	The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)

	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐστιν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί
