### Meaning

\* To kneel \* To bless God as an act of adoration \* To bless man as a benefit \* Sometimes, to curse

Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament.

The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 בָּרַךְ plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_big בָּרַךְ

hebrew

The Hebrew בָּרַךְ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרַךְ אֱלֹהִים ( אֱלֹהִים הַמַּלְאָךְ דָּוִד לְאֹמֶר יֵשׁוּב ) בָּרַךְ אֱלֹהִים plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_big בָּרַךְ
