Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (יִלְדָה אַחֲרַי אֲבִשָּׁלוֹם)
ESV	His father had never at any time displeased him by asking, “Why have you done thus and so?” He was also a very handsome man, and he was born next after Absalom.
NIV	(His father had never interfered with him by asking, “Why do you behave as you do?” He was also very handsome and was born next after Absalom.)
NLT	Now his father, King David, had never disciplined him at any time, even by asking, “Why are you doing that?” Adonijah had been born next after Absalom, and he was very handsome.
