ESV	while twelve lions stood there, one on each end of a step on the six steps. The like of it was never made in any kingdom.
NIV	Twelve lions stood on the six steps, one at either end of each step. Nothing like it had ever been made for any other kingdom.
NLT	There were also twelve other lions, one standing on each end of the six steps. No other throne in all the world could be compared with it!
