ESV	And the time that Jeroboam reigned was twenty-two years. And he slept with his fathers, and Nadab his son reigned in his place.
NIV	He reigned for twenty-two years and then rested with his fathers. And Nadab his son succeeded him as king.
NLT	Jeroboam reigned in Israel twenty-two years. When Jeroboam died, his son Nadab became the next king.
