Hebrew	The word הִיְהִי means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים וַיְהִי
ESV	The rest of the acts of Abijah and all that he did, are they not written in the Book of the Chronicles of the Kings of Judah? And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.
NIV	As for the other events of Abijah's reign, and all he did, are they not written in the book of the annals of the kings of Judah? There was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.
NLT	The rest of the events in Abijah's reign and everything he did are recorded in [The Book of the History of the Kings of Judah.] There was constant war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

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KJV Now the rest of the acts of Abijam, and all that he did, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? And there was war between Abijam and Jeroboam.
