The Hebrew **את** word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article **הַ**. Genesis 1:1 **הָפֶר אֲשֶׁר נָתַן לָהֶם וַיַּעֲשׂוּ וַיִּקְרְאוּ בְּשֵׁם הַבְּעַל** **מִהֶבֶקֶר וְעַד הַצִּהָרִים לֵאמֹר הַבְּעַל עָנָנוּ וַאֲנִי קוֹל וַאֲנִי עֲנָה וַיִּפְסְחוּ עַל הַמִּזְבֵּחַ אֲשֶׁר עָשָׂה**
