	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּגֵי וַתְּאֹמֶר אֵלֶיו דַּבֵּר
ESV	And now I have one request to make of you; do not refuse me." She said to him, "Speak."
NIV	Now I have one request to make of you. Do not refuse me. You may make it, " she said.
NLT	So now I have just one favor to ask of you. Please don't turn me down." "What is it?" she asked.
