Hebrew	The Hebrew אָת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵא אֱלֹהִים (הַדְּבַר הַזֶּה עָשָׂה הַסֵּר הַמְלָכִים אִישׁ מִמְּקוֹמוֹ וְשִׁים פְּחוֹת תַּחְתֵּיהֶם
ESV	And do this: remove the kings, each from his post, and put commanders in their places,
NIV	Do this: Remove all the kings from their commands and replace them with other officers.
NLT	Only this time replace the kings with field commanders!

	* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens

	Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9
