	The Hebrew אַת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ.Genesis 1:1 אָבֶר אָפְּאָר
ESV	In the spring, Ben-hadad mustered the Syrians and went up to Aphek to fight against Israel.
NIV	The next spring Ben-Hadad mustered the Arameans and went up to Aphek to fight against Israel.
NLT	The following spring he called up the Aramean army and marched out against Israel, this time at Aphek.
