Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

When used with the genitive case, *διὰ* emphasizes the means or channel by which something happens. John 1:3 Matthew 24:12 John 1:32 Timothy 2:10 Romans 5:1 John 1:17 *τοῦτο* plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:16 1 John 5:11 1 Corinthians 15:50 1 John 4:9 John 5:1 Matthew 3:17 John 7:26 Luke 22:19 *ἐκραταίωσεν ὑπὲρ ἡμᾶς ἐὰν δὲ* plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big

δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. *πολεμήσωμεν αὐτούς* plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big αὐτός

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
