Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. וְלֹא אָכַל לֶחֶם

NIV	So Ahab went home, sullen and angry because Naboth the Jezreelite had said, "I will not give you the inheritance of my fathers." He lay on his bed sulking and refused to eat.
NLT	So Ahab went home angry and sullen because of Naboth's answer. The king went to bed with his face to the wall and refused to eat!
