ESV	Then two prostitutes came to the king and stood before him.
NIV	Now two prostitutes came to the king and stood before him.
NLT	Some time later two prostitutes came to the king to have an argument settled.
LXX	τότε ὡφθησαν δύο γυναῖκες πόρνοι τῷ greek The definite article βασιλεῖ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἔστησαν ἐνώπιον αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
