	יהוה יהוה autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning Hebrew * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 עד הַיָּמִים הָהֵם
ESV	The people were sacrificing at the high places, however, because no house had yet been built for the name of the LORD.
NIV	The people, however, were still sacrificing at the high places, because a temple had not yet been built for the Name of the LORD.
NLT	At that time the people of Israel sacrificed their offerings at local places of worship, for a temple honoring the name of the LORD had not yet been built.
LXX	πλὴν ὁ autotooltip_big greek The definite article λαὸς ἦσαν autotooltip_big greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. θυμῶντες ἐπὶ τοῖς autotooltip_big greek The definite article ὑψηλοῖς ὅτι οὐκ ᾤκοδομήθη οἶκος τῷ autotooltip_big greek The definite article ὀνόματι κυρίου ἕως νῦν
KJV	Only the people sacrificed in high places, because there was no house built unto the name of the LORD, until those days.

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
