ESV	The capitals were on the two pillars and also above the rounded projection which was beside the latticework. There were two hundred pomegranates in two rows all around, and so with the other capital.
NIV	On the capitals of both pillars, above the bowl-shaped part next to the network, were the two hundred pomegranates in rows all around.
NLT	The capitals on the two pillars had 200 pomegranates in two rows around them, beside the rounded surface next to the latticework.
