	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

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ESV	Thus all the work that King Solomon did on the house of the LORD was finished. NIV	When all the work King Solomon had done for the temple of the LORD was finished, he brought in the things his father David had dedicated-the silver and gold and the furnishings-and he placed them in the treasuries of the LORD's temple.
NLT	So King Solomon finished all his work on the Temple of the LORD. Then he brought all the gifts his father, David, had dedicated- the silver, the gold, and the various articles- and he stored them in the treasuries of the LORD's Temple.
