Meaning:

* To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend

The verb שְׁמֶר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament.

Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9 Psalm 121:7 Deuteronomy 7:11 Psalm 127:1 Luke 2:19 אֲשֶׁר לְעִבְדְּךָ דָּנָה אֱלֹהֵי אֶת plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאֶת

hebrew

The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. Genesis 1:1 אֲשֶׁר דִּבַּרְתָּ לוֹ וַתְּדַבֵּר בְּפִיךָ וּבִידְךָ מְלֵאֲתָ כִּיּוֹם הַזֶּה
