	ὥς ἐλεύθεροι, καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μὴ ὥς ἐπικάλυμμα ἔχοντες τῆς greek The definite article κακίας τὴν greek The definite article ἐλευθερίαν, ἀλλ’ ὥς θεοῦ greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God δοῦλοι.
ESV	Live as people who are free, not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God.
NIV	Live as free men, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as servants of God.
NLT	For you are free, yet you are God's slaves, so don't use your freedom as an excuse to do evil.
KJV	As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.

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
